Avenue Molière, close to Place Brugmann, a remarkable pre-modernist style house designed at the request of lawyer Charles Gheude, based on the plans of architects Antoine Pompe and Fernand Bodson, 1913. Built on a plot of 3a60, the house has an area of 611m² (according to the EPC) and features 5 bedrooms and 5 bathrooms.

The façade is punctuated by unaligned bay windows, allowing for a magnificent play of light throughout the living spaces. Beautiful terrace and garden in complete tranquility. Spacious garage. EPC C. Full file available upon request.
